Terraform is an open-source software tool that provides a consistent CLI workflow to provision and configure public cloud services. Ansible is a widely adopted open-source provisioning, configuration management and enterprise service deployment tool that can be used to fully automate the delivery of Redis Enterprise within a self-managed cloud environment.
